Europe for Gender Equality? Taking Stock — Taking Action

30 September – 1 October 2019, Finlandia Hall, Mannerheimintie 13, Helsinki, Finland

The European Union and Member States have taken important steps towards gender equality. However, many long-standing challenges remain and new questions have emerged on the gender equality agenda in the 2000s.

It is time now, at the beginning of the new term of the European Parliament and the European Commission, to take stock of key trends of gender equality in the EU and discuss the directions for future action. The 25th anniversary of the United Nations Beijing Platform for Action offers an opportunity to assess the progress made in gender equality and to reflect on future orientation of EU gender equality policies, including the integration of gender equality into all EU activities.
